

Jonah's Guide to the **Agentic Future**

how to become a developer **without ever opening a code editor**. follow the steps top to bottom. do not skip. do not improvise. do not ask questions until it works.

✂ **THE GOLDEN RULE (memorize this):** any error in the terminal → copy the **WHOLE** thing → paste it into **claude.ai** in your browser → type back what it says → repeat. literally just brute force it. this rule solves every problem in this guide.

0 Crack a Celsius

non-negotiable. this is fuel. **mango guava is the recommended flavor**. other flavors work — they're just wrong.

1 Get a Claude subscription

go to **claude.ai** → sign up → subscribe. **Max plan preferred** — it's the engine, don't cheap out on the engine. remember which email you used. you'll log in with it in step 5.

2 Make a folder called **projects**

anywhere on your computer. desktop is fine. this folder is home now.

mac: right-click the folder → "New Terminal at Folder" · **windows:** open the folder → right-click empty space → "Open in Terminal". a scary black box opens. good.

3 Open claude.ai in your browser and paste exactly this

COPY-PASTE THIS MESSAGE

"I have a [Mac / Windows] computer and I have never used a terminal. Walk me through installing Claude Code, ONE command at a time, and wait for me to confirm each one worked. I also want an alias so that typing **cc** runs **claude --dangerously-skip-permissions**. Do not move on until each step works."

4 Type what it tells you into the terminal

it may make you install **node** and **homebrew** first. that's fine. that's part of it. you do not stop. errors? **golden rule**. you keep going until the terminal shows Claude.

5 Log in when it asks

the first time Claude Code runs, it opens your browser to log in. use the account from **step 1**. this is the step everyone forgets exists.

6 Close the terminal. Reopen it. Type **cc**

the **cc** shortcut only exists in NEW terminal windows — so close it, right-click the folder again, new terminal, type **cc**, hit enter. Claude appears? **you did it. smile**. doesn't? golden rule.

CHECKPOINT

from this moment on, forever: **right-click the projects folder** → **new terminal** → type **cc** → **enter**. that is the entire workflow. now flip the page and hand it the keys.

7 Hand Claude the keys *the trick nobody tells you: you paste keys INTO the claude terminal, and tell it to remember them.*

+ Cloudflare — free hosting + databases for everything you build

make a free account at cloudflare.com. then: click the **person icon (top right)** → **My Profile** → **API Tokens** → **Create Token** → **Create Custom Token**. give it one permission: **Account** → **API Tokens** → **Edit**. create it, copy it. now go to your **cc** terminal and type: **"this is my cloudflare api key: [paste]. save it, and use it to create any other keys you need. you handle all hosting and databases from now on."** that's a master key — it goes into your claude and NOWHERE else. you never log into cloudflare again.

+ OpenRouter — every other AI model, for pennies

make an account at openrouter.ai → add \$10 of credits → **Keys** → **Create Key** → copy. tell your claude: **"this is my openrouter key: [paste]. save it. when anything I build needs AI for boring grunt work, use the cheapest gemini flash model on openrouter."** save the claude brainpower for the real stuff.

+ Optional, for the ambitious

hikerapi.com if you want to scrape social media. **zernio** if you're running ads. same move: make the account, get the key, paste it into your claude, tell it what it's for.

8 Build something. Right now. *don't overthink your first one.*

TYPE THINGS LIKE THIS INTO CC

"build me a website for [your thing] and put it live on the internet with cloudflare."

"make a tool that checks [competitor]'s prices every morning and emails me what changed."

"build me a page where people drop their email and it saves to a database."

the sauce, in full: right-click the projects folder. new terminal. type **cc**. say what you want. it builds it, hosts it, fixes it when it breaks — you just keep talking. **you're a developer now. this is not a metaphor. this is tuesday.**

(no code editor. no github — yet. when you start building real projects, learn github. until then: internal tools, full send.)

THE SHORTCUT

Talking is free. The setup costs money.

want to talk growth or distribution? **calls are free**. want me to personally build this entire setup with you — Claude Code, Cloudflare, OpenRouter, keys, your first working tool, all of it? that's the done-for-you setup: **\$3,000 flat**. you leave the call a developer.
